Foreign Postal Rates 1918-1925

This Exhibit demonstrates the effect of inflation on Austrian Foreign Postal Rates for the period September 1918 to October 1925 using printed matter, postcards, letters, registered postcards and letters, express delivery and airmail.

The Exhibit commences with the rates in force at the end of World War I, which continued following the break up of the Austro-Hungarian Empire and covers the 14 rate periods and concludes with the new currency rates that were introduced from March 1, 1925. During this time, the cost of a basic foreign letter increased by a factor of 8000. The Exhibit is presented chronologically with each new rate period having bold details and subsequent pages being in grey.

The Exhibit traverses three economic states:

Inflation: [September 1918 – August 1921] when the basic letter rate increased **20-fold** from 25h to 5Kr;

Hyperinflation: [December 1921 – September 1922] when the ordinary letter rate increased **125-fold** from 5Kr to 600Kr;

Stabilisation and New Currency: [September 1922 – October 1925] when rates increased **6.7-fold**. The new currency was introduced at 100Kr to 1 gr.

The Austro-Hungarian Empire was broken up in the aftermath of WWI and Austria emerged with much of the combined public debt and few of the productive assets including most of the bureaucracy that had run the Empire. Food production was severely reduced. Hunger and economic uncertainty during and after the war led to Governmental instability with balanced budgets a low priority. The economic-defined hyperinflation period was the eleven months from August 1921.

Stabilisation came suddenly and decisively in August 1922 when the new Government began negotiating for a 650 million gold crown foreign loan to be guaranteed by Czechoslovakia, Britain and France. The loan became collateral from October 1922 and an actual transfer of fund in early 1923. The final element of economic reorganisation was the introduction of new currency, which was effectively a 10000-fold devaluation.
