# Poland Postage Due 1919 30-value - Plate Study





This exhibit is the philatelic evidence of **original research** being carried out by the exhibitor into the printing and plate varieties of the 1919 Postage Due issue. Colonel Larking recorded no constant flaw on this value in his 1930 article. Issued in October 1919 and printed by typography.

Close examination of a sheet and blocks of stamps show that constant flaws exist on alternate rows indicating that the plates were produced from 2 rows of 10 stamps repeated 5 times. The same flaws exist in both the Red issue Value in fennigow for Northern Poland and Blue issue Value in halerzy for Southern Poland indicating they were prepared from the same printing plates. This applies to some other values of each issue. The explanation is as follows.

A steel engraved die was prepared and hardened. It was used to create a form of 20 impressions in 2 rows of 10. This was hardened and used to prepare 5 identical copper electrotype forms that were used to construct the printing plate for the 1919 Postage Due issues. This may be a unique stamp printing method of printing plate construction and is not noted in any Literature.

Using a digital microscope and a sheet and available blocks of the 30-value, constant plate varieties have been identified for 9 stamp positions on the Odd numbered rows and for 8 of the 10 stamps in Even numbered rows.



### **Forgeries**

A forgery is known of the 30 fen for the issue for Northern Poland.

- The shade is more orange than the legitimate issue
- The printing is very poor quality
- They are line perforated  $10.5 \times 10.5$ .
- None of identified constant plate flaws are seen on the forgery.













A forgery is known of the 30 fen for the issue for Southern Poland.

- The shade a lighter blue than the legitimate issue
- The printing is very poor quality
- They are line perforated  $10.5 \times 10.5$ .
- None of identified constant plate flaws are seen on the forgery.











### Sheet Construction & Nomenclature

 Odd Number Rows
 1; 3; 5; 7; 9.

 Even Number Rows
 2; 4; 6; 8; 10.

The identified plate flaws occur in 5 positions.



#### **Major Flaws**

- Irregular "C": Large white flaw on "C" of "POCZTA" This flaw is much less evident on R1/7 and R5/7




